

## ROCKY MOUNTAIN REBELS

Minutes of the meeting held at Austin's Steak House on 6-8-2011.

Jay Andresen called the meeting to order with 34 members in attendance.

Zac Farrelgave the treasurers report and noted that we have \$194.30 remaining to spend on door prizes. The T-shirts have been paid for at a cost of approximately \$1100.00. Shannon Watts is working on a mystery bike and hopes to have the selection finalized in the near future.

Lyle Miller said the kids inflatables program is all set for the car show.

Randy Nipper is arranging a meeting with Ron Hammer at CWC in the near future. Discussion followed on the need for at least one ramp which will have to be constructed before the show.

Shannon Watts said the car show information will appear in the Rendezvous Committee ads and website. Mike Forget suggested we arrange for television ads and noted that the airtime is very inexpensive. He will contact the television representative and have them contact Shannon Watts. Jay Andresen said we should also do radio ads.

Dunc Salum said the swap meet continues to develop with primarily local participation.

Zac Farrel and Dan Higinbotham plan to start reconstruction of the burn-out pads in two weeks. They will ask for assistance as necessary and it was suggested that we construct the new ramps at the same time.

Jay Andresen reported that arrangements have been made for the porta-potties and he noted that we no longer have someone to help set up the biker games. Steve Harless enthusiastically volunteered to contact Cedar Bar and see if someone else is taking care of this activity.

Julie Andresen reported that we are in good shape on the forms for this year's car show.

Jay Andresen noted that we can start parking cars in the lobby at Kmart beginning June 20<sup>th</sup>. We will rotate vehicles (cars and

or bikes) every three or four days until the car show. Please let him know if you are interested in having your vehicle displayed at Kmart.

Shannon Watts noted that the trophies are being constructed as we speak.

Rex Rogers reported that the Studebaker Club would like to put up a certificate and/or check to be selected and awarded by their local chapter at the car show. The members present unanimously approved their offer. He also presented information on future Studebaker Club activities and said they hope to have a car show in Lander shortly after Labor Day and will give us the pertinent information as the date approaches so we can disseminate it to the rest of the Rocky Mountain Rebels.
